The Master Teacher...

This week's edition of *The Master Teacher*<u>Five Elements of Highly Effective Teams</u>
explores three facets of adult group work
and five dimensions of collaboration. How
do we stack up as a school? How do our
PLC's stack up against what is described?

The article describes that three overarching facets of group work can contribute to positive results. They are:

- 1. Team members use their influence to make sure instructional practices support student needs.
- School structures are modified when they aren't serving the best interest of students.
- 3. Power and responsibility are shared, regardless of length of service, position, etc.

The article further describes five dimensions of collaboration that provide a trajectory for team growth and renewal. These are listed as:

1. **Problem Solving**: Finding solutions to issues, not placing blame.

- 2. **Reflection**: Looking at data, analyzing the impact our decisions have on student achievement.
- Common Language: What does good teaching mean to each of us? If we are talking the same language, good teaching means the same thing.
- 4. **Trust**: Described as the "social oxygen" of a school, are we oxygen rich here at LSHS? Do you trust your colleagues? Do you trust us in the office? Or are we gasping for air? What do we need to do to build trust in one another?
- 5. Challenging Assumptions: The ability to question thinking and assumptions and break the "culture of nice" can lead to deep conversations and honest opinions regarding how we do things (without offending each other!)
